- 1) Visit the Anderson County Museum and take a self-guided tour.
- 2) Find the oil painting of the fountain inside the museum and take a picture in front of it.
- 3) The Robert Anderson Fountain was named for American Revolutionary War Officer General Robert E. Anderson. Come see the newly restored Robert Anderson Fountain in the museum's Heritage Garden. Look carefully at the fountain, in what year was it erected? Please do not get into the fountain as it would not be safe to do so.
- 4) Read about the history of the Robert Anderson Fountain on our museum website.
